Students who have met the requirements for graduation will be allowed to participate in the commencement proceedings provided they abide by the proceedings organized by the school district. It is the responsibility of the principal to solicit input from each graduating class regarding the proceedings for the commencement

The high school principal will compile a list of candidates for graduation for board approval.

Students who have successfully completed three and one half years of the required academic program may participate in commencement exercises. The required credits for commencement participation are outlined in policy 505.05.

Those students completing requirements to receive a G-LR Alternative School diploma may participate in commencement exercises.

Students who fail to meet the academic required credits by commencement date, will be denied the opportunity to participate in commencement. Upon completion of the required credits, students will be issued a George-Little Rock diploma. They may participate in commencement on the date that is most near the time when the graduation requirements are met.

Failure of a student to participate in commencement will not be a reason for withholding the student's final progress report or diploma certifying the student's completion of high school.
