

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES
April 14, 2014

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in regular session on April 14, 2014 in the Middle School library in Little Rock. Board president Amy Jurrens called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. after which the pledge of allegiance was recited.

Present were board members Ryan Klingenberg, and via telephone Curt Fiedler. Also present were Superintendent Steve Barber, Secretary Delinda Kruger, and guests Valecia West and Stacie VerSteeg.

A motion to adopt the agenda was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 3-0.

The public hearing for the proposed 2014-15 budget was held. Mr. Barber explained that the new tax rate will be \$12.27 and the income surtax rate 14%.

A motion was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 3-0 to approve the minutes of the March 10 meeting.

Fiedler moved to approve and pay the bills as presented. Klingenberg seconded and the motion carried 3-0.

A motion to approve the financial reports was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 3-0.

The following resignations were presented for consideration: Barb Grotluschen, custodian; Glee Wiersma, paraeducator; Chelsey Mersbergen, Spanish and Volleyball coach; Heather Keizer, Assistant Volleyball coach. A motion to approve all of the resignations was made by Fiedler, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 3-0. The board extended thanks and appreciation for their years of service to the district. On May 7, a reception will be held for all of the retirees. It will be held in the commons area from 4:00 to 6:00 P.M. and will be open to the community.

A motion was made by Klingenberg, and seconded by Jurrens to approve Trev Fiedler as a volunteer track coach. Voting aye were Ryan Klingenberg and Amy Jurrens. Curt Fiedler abstained from the vote. Motion carried.

A motion to adopt the proposed 2014-15 budget was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 3-0.

A motion was made by Klingenberg, and seconded by Fiedler to adopt the following Resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the George-Little Rock Community School District, will levy property tax for fiscal year 2014-15 for the regular program budget adjustment as allowed under section 257.14, Code of Iowa.

A roll call vote was taken with Ryan Klingenberg, Curt Fiedler, and Amy Jurrens voting aye. Nays: none. Motion carried 3-0 to approve the resolution.

The next meeting will be held on April 22, 2014 at 8:00 P.M. in George.

A motion to adjourn was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 3-0.
