

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL  
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES  
July 30, 2012

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on July 30, 2012 in the Middle School Library at Little Rock. Board president Amy Jurens called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M. and welcomed everyone. Board members present were Terrence Clark, Doug Krull, Ryan Klingenberg, and Curt Fiedler. Also in attendance were Superintendent Janel Guse, Principal Molly Schilling, Secretary Delinda Kruger, and approximately fifty guests.

Mrs. Guse updated the information regarding the fire escape issue at Little Rock. The current fire escape was built in the 90's when the chute was removed. In April, the fire marshal cited the fire escape to be unsafe. She assured everyone that it is not about closing the building, but how to keep it open.

Koch-Hazard Architects have been working with the fire marshal as to what changes are required to be able to use the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors. They can have a schematic drawing with an approximate cost for the project completed by August 13. The cost for this will be \$2,500 plus travel, and other costs. A motion was made by Krull, seconded by Clark, and carried 5-0 to accept the proposal from Koch Hazard.

Mrs. Guse will apply for a variance from the State for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors for the 2012-13 school year.

A motion to adjourn was made by Clark, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 5-0.
