

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL  
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES  
November 1, 2013

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on November 1, 2013 in the Superintendent's office at George. Board president Amy Jurrens called the meeting to order at 8:30 A.M. Present were board members Curt Fiedler and via telephone, Ryan Klingenberg. Doug Krull and Wade Netten were absent. Also present were Superintendent Steve Barber, Secretary Delinda Kruger, and Paul Denekas.

A motion to adopt the agenda was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 3-0.

The meeting was held to consider the purchase of a van to replace the one that was totaled in the recent accident. A quote in the amount of \$22,975 for a 2014 Chevrolet Express 8 passenger van was received from VanderLee Motors, Rock Rapids. A motion was made by Fiedler, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 3-0 to approve the purchase of the van per the quoted price.
