

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES
May 28, 2015

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on May 28, 2015 in the High School Library at George. Board president Amy Jurrens called the meeting to order at 5:40 P.M. and the pledge of allegiance was recited. Board members present were Ryan Klingenberg and Wade Netten. Also present was Superintendent Steve Barber, and guest Shari Kruse.

A motion was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Netten, and carried 3-0 to approve the agenda with one addition.

A motion was made by Netten, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 3-0 to approve the bills as presented.

Motion made by Netten, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 3-0 to acknowledge the receipt of the financial reports for April.

Motion by Klingenberg, seconded by Netten, and carried 3-0 to accept the resignation of Carissa Janssen as special education teacher/aide and cheerleader sponsor, and Heather Keizer as Middle School Language Arts and Middle School track coach. The board thanked both of them for their service to the GLR district and students.

Motion by Netten, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 3-0 to accept the resignation of Curt Fiedler as high school track and field coach. The board thanked Coach Fiedler for sharing his knowledge as a runner and providing leadership for the program.

Motion by Klingenberg, seconded by Netten, and carried 3-0 to approve Cathy Bonestroo as School Business Official at \$50,000 per year, Zach Fugitt as Summer Rec Coordinator at \$1500, and Molly Schilling as MS Activities Director at \$8100, which includes an additional 17 contract days. Mr. Barber explained the openings that still remain for the upcoming year including; HS Spanish, MS Language Arts, Assistant Volleyball, MS Boys Basketball, Cheerleading Sponsor, MS track and Field, .5 at-risk coordinator, paraprofessional.

Motion by Klingenberg, seconded by Netten, and carried 3-0 to approve the 2015-16 certified negotiation total package of 3.45%, which includes the cost of single insurance for the \$750 deductible plan, plus a 1.5% increase on individual salary and a \$1,225 fixed increase per FTE. The district will divide the union dues over the number of months after the union membership is received. Extra pay for the National Honor Society sponsor was added to Schedule B at \$500.

Motion by Netten, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 3-0 to adjourn.
