

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on Wednesday, December 21 in the Library in George. Board President Doug Krull called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Doug Krull, Wade Netten, Todd Klein, Curt Fiedler, and Ryan Klingenberg. Also in attendance were Superintendent Steve Barber and Board Secretary Cathy Bonestroo. A quorum was established. With no citizens present, no discussion was brought forward.

Discussion was held regarding the at-risk application and possible changes proposed with the shared liaison officer. A motion to approve the modified at-risk allowable growth in the amount of \$151,183 was made by Netten, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 5-0.

Discussion was held regarding the George elementary HVAC project with modifications to the original plans proposed. A motion to approve the bid process for the George Elementary HVAC project was made by Netten, seconded by Klein, and carried 5-0.
