

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL  
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on February 22, 2017 in the Library in Little Rock. Board President Doug Krull called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Doug Krull, Wade Netten, Todd Klein, Curt Fiedler, and Ryan Klingenberg. Also in attendance were Superintendent Steve Barber and Board Secretary Cathy Bonestroo. A quorum was established. No citizens were present to address the board.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Netten, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 5-0.

Discussion was held regarding the role of a model teacher and the qualifications needed for a liaison officer. A motion to approve the resignations from Jeff Jager as Liaison Officer and Karie Aeikens as model teacher, both effective at the end of the 2016-17 school year, was made by Klingenberg, seconded by Netten and carried 5-0. Board expressed their appreciation for their service to the district.

A motion for closed session in accordance with Iowa Code Chapter 21.51 (I) to update board on superintendent goals was made by Netten and seconded by Fiedler. Roll call vote was taken with Netten, Fiedler, Klein, Klingenberg, and Krull all ayes, and no nays, carried 5-0. Closed session began at 5:40 pm.

A motion to return to open session was made by Fiedler, seconded by Netten. Roll call vote was taken with Netten, Fiedler, Klein, Klingenberg, and Krull all ayes, and no nays, carried 5-0. The meeting returned to open session at 6:45 pm.

A motion to adjourn was made by Netten, seconded by Klein, and carried 5-0.

A work session was held following the special meeting regarding changes to collective bargaining with the legislation change, current financial position for FY17, Central Lyon Sharing agreement, and personnel needs.
