GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on April 19 in the Library in George. Board President Doug Krull called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Board members present were Doug Krull, Wade Netten, Todd Klein, and Ryan Klingenberg. Curt Fiedler had not yet arrived but was expected. Also in attendance were Board Secretary Cathy Bonestroo and Les Douma from Douma Consulting. A quorum was established. No citizens were present to address the board.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Netten, seconded by Klein, and carried 4-0.

Curt Fiedler arrived at 6:05 pm. Les Douma reported on the superintendent search including the interview schedule for April 26, interview details, discussion of interview questions and inadvisable questions, focus group responses, and miscellaneous items for the interview day such as room locations, food, and the rating sheets process.

A motion to enter closed session as provided in section 21.5(1)(i) of the Open Meetings Law to evaluate the professional competencies of individuals whose hiring is being considered was made by Fiedler and seconded by Klein. A roll call vote was taken with Netten, Klein, Klingenberg, Krull, and Fiedler all ayes and no nays. Board entered closed session at 6:35 pm to review applicants for the superintendent position.

The board returned to open session at 8:45 pm.

A motion to approve interviews on April 26 for 3 superintendent candidates including Mr. John Eyerly, Superintendent of Schools from Westfield Schools in Wisconsin; Dr. Adam Zellmer, Director of Teaching & Learning from Webster City Schools in Iowa; and Mr. Shawn Kreman, High School Principal, from Iowa Valley Marengo Schools in Iowa; with one alternate also selected. Motion was made by Fiedler, seconded by Netten, carried 5-0.

A motion to adjourn was made by Fiedler, seconded by Klingenberg, and carried 5-0.
