

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on Tuesday, August 8, 2017 in the Superintendent's office in George. Board Vice-President Curt Fiedler called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Curt Fiedler with Todd Klein and Doug Krull joining by electronic means per Iowa Code 21.8, as they couldn't attend in person. Also in attendance were Superintendent John Eyerly, Board Secretary Cathy Bonestroo, and Principal Kevin Range. A quorum was established. Citizens were invited to address the board with no discussion brought forward.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Klein, seconded by Krull, and carried 3-0.

A motion to approve the recommendation for hire of Crystal DeBoer, elementary secretary in George at \$12.00 per hour, was made by Krull, seconded by Klein and carried 3-0.

Ryan Klingenberg joined by electronic means per Iowa Code 21.8 as he was unable to attend in person.

Discussion was held regarding pest control found during the wiring project. Bids were received from 3 companies. Superintendent Eyerly recommended Orkin due to the full research, national reputation, and thoroughness they had done with concerns of other bids having possible increases once project is started. Discussion was held that the priority was to take care of the situation for the best interest of the students, faculty, and community and to open the school in a timely fashion. Staff training may need to be moved to another building during the process with possible school start date changed too. Board approved calendar fluctuation if needed. A motion to approve the bid from Orkin for \$50,550 for bat exclusion and decontamination in the high school and adding R49 insulation to the original building for \$25,300 was made by Krull, seconded by Klein, and carried 4-0.

A motion to adjourn was made by Krull seconded by Klein, and carried 4-0.
