



2020-21 GLR Visitor Protocols and Procedures with COVID19

Deliveries will drop off packages, etc. inside the door of each building.

Visitors will be asked to sign in and sign a waiver and follow all protocols.
Visitors entering the buildings will be required to wear face masks.

PPE products will be on site if needed by all entrances of GLR campuses.

Top 5 important strategies for students and staff of the Mustang Family

1. **Stay home:** Keep your student home if they have any of the following high-risk symptoms - new cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, new loss of taste or smell; or two or more low risk symptoms- fever, headache, muscle and body aches, sore throat, runny nose, congestion, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.
2. **Socially distance:** From buses to classrooms, in the lunchroom and other areas, we will do our best to keep students (6) feet from one another.
3. **Face coverings:** When students and staff cannot maintain their (6) feet of social distance, we recommend students and staff wear a face covering-mask or face shield.
4. **Hand sanitizing:** Students and staff are strongly encouraged to carry a personalized bottle of sanitizer to use frequently as possible during a typical school day. Each classroom will have a hand sanitizer at each door, students will be required to sanitize on their way into the classroom and upon their exit.
5. **Visitors:** All visitors, including parents/guardians, should call ahead before coming to school, and are strongly encouraged to make an appointment before arriving unannounced on our GLR campuses. Visitors may be asked to remain in the designated area before granted access and may be limited to the office area.
