

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL  
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on Thursday, February 1, 2018 in the Superintendent's office in George. Curt Fiedler called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Curt Fiedler and Todd Klein with Doug Krull and Wade Netten joining by conference call. Kristi Landis was unable to attend. Also in attendance were Superintendent John Eyerly and Board Secretary Cathy Bonestroo. A quorum was established. No citizens were present to address the board.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Netten, seconded by Krull, and carried 4-0.

Discussion was held about the girls' middle school basketball program with just one current coach. It was originally felt that due to the low numbers, one coach could handle the program with one coach out on leave. No concerns have been addressed directly to Mr. Eyerly. However, a parent meeting was held with players, parents, and Mrs. Schilling. Some concerns were discussed about mixing the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams with about 11-12 total players with additional concerns about the different skill levels for all players, and the game situation for one person to handle checking out and next game preparations.

A motion to approve Joel Hoogland as Girls Middle School Basketball coach for the remainder of the season with 33% of the season remaining with a pro-rated contract of \$710.49 was made by Krull, seconded by Klein, and carried 4-0.

A motion to adjourn at approximately 12:05 was made by Klein, seconded by Netten, and carried 4-0.
