BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met in special session on Tuesday, May 14, 2019 in the Superintendent Office in George. Board Vice-President Wade Netten called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present via phone were Wade Netten, Doug Krull, and Todd Klein. Curt Fiedler and Kristi Landis were unable to attend. Also in attendance were Superintendent John Eyerly, Board Secretary Cathy Bonestroo, Principal Molly Schilling, Principal Steve Green, and guests Nyla Hellinga and Valecia West.

A quorum was established. Citizens were invited to address the board with no public comment received.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Krull, seconded by Klein, and carried 3-0.

A motion to accept the resignation of Jordan Kruse as paraprofessional, Middle School Football coach, MS Boys Basketball Coach, Head Softball Coach, Baseball/Softball/Football Field Maintenance, and Substitute Bus Driver was made by Krull, seconded by Klein, and carried 3-0.

A motion to table the approval of a Spanish teacher was made by Klein, seconded by Krull, and carried 3-0.

Fiedler arrived at 12:08 pm.

A motion to table the approval to proceed with a contract with CMBA Architects for architectural services and construction management at \$11,000 - \$18,000 for the bathroom remodel required from the equity visit noting preference of work to be completed by local contractors was made by Krull, seconded by Fiedler, and carried 4-0. Discussion was held regarding the dollar amount and how it seems to be a high percentage of the total project if only proceeding with 2 bathrooms. It was noted that the superintendent will follow up with the range of dollars to be confirmed to be a more definite number and possibly present drawings at the May 20 meeting.

The next regular board meeting will be held May 20, 2019 in George at 7 pm with a closed session for superintendent evaluation.

A motion to adjourn at 12:20 pm was made by Fiedler, seconded by Klein, and carried 4-0.
