

GEORGE-LITTLE ROCK COMMUNITY SCHOOL  
BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES

The George-Little Rock Board of Education met for special session on Tuesday, November 10, 2020 in the Superintendent Office/Board Room in the GLR district building in George. Board President Kristi Landis called the meeting to order at 1:00 pm. Board members present via phone were Kristi Landis, Andrew Sprock, Jason Fugitt, and Austin Lloyd. Wade Netten was unable to attend. Also in attendance in person were Superintendent Tom Luxford, Board Secretary Cathy Bonestroo, and guest Darcy Hansmann.

A quorum was established. President Landis opened the meeting for public comment. No paperwork was received for public comment and no public comment was made.

A motion to adopt the adjusted agenda which added the communication of the summary of enhanced public health measures from the Governor's noon press conference was made by Lloyd, seconded by Fugitt, and carried 4-0.

A motion to approve the recommendation for hire of Parker Netten as substitute paraprofessional at \$9.50 per hour was made by Fugitt, seconded by Lloyd, and carried 4-0. Superintendent Luxford shared there is an increase need for subs due to COVID absences and symptoms.

Superintendent Luxford shared the communication received from Okoboji schools and read the summary of enhanced public measures which becomes effective November 11 from the November 10 noon conference of Governor Reynolds. He wanted to bring awareness to the board and is researching how to interpret the measures for schools. In question were what it means for school attendance and wearing masks. The upcoming football game was also questioned. Updates will be sent as soon as more information is learned. He anticipates more information from the Iowa High School Athletic Association and anticipates an impact to the game and other events.

A motion to adjourn at 1:10 pm was made by Fugitt, seconded by Sprock, and carried 4-0.
