	First Offense:
	The above student has violated the Student Internet Policy by intentionally accessing restricted material. He/she may lose Internet access for up to three weeks at the discretion of the supervising teacher. A first offense will result in the student losing Internet access for a period of 3 weeks.
	Second Offense:
	The above student has violated the Student Internet Policy by intentionally accessing restricted material for a second time. As a consequence of this violation the above student has lost Internet access for a period of 9 weeks.
	Third Offense:
	The above student has violated the Student Internet Policy by intentionally accessing restricted material for a third time. As a consequence of this violation the above student has forfeited all Internet privileges for a period of 18 weeks or the balance of the school year.
	has forfeited all Internet privileges for a period of 18 weeks or the balance of the school

The above are minimum consequences and may be more severe should the violation warrant. Such decisions will be made by the administration. Violations of state and federal laws will be handled by the proper authorities.
